Program Aide Core Training A GSCOC Volunteer-Led Event

Discover new leadership skills, **Connect** with others, and prepare to **Take Action** through service as a Program Aide working with younger children. Girl Scout Cadettes, Seniors, and Ambassadors in grades 6-12 are invited to participate in Program Aide Core Training.

- DATE:** Various dates are available. **Girls must attend both Session 1 and Session 2.**
- TIME:** Saturdays, 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. OR Session 1 and Session 2 Overnight in April
- LOCATION:** Various locations are available.
- COST:** \$20 per girl per session (\$40 total per girl)
Fee includes training materials, Program Aide pin, Zink patch, and snacks.
Girls should plan to bring a sack lunch for Saturday training.
- OPEN TO:** Girl Scout Cadettes, Seniors, and Ambassadors, Grades 6-12
- MIN/MAX:** 15/50 girls

REGISTRATION OPENS: January 15, 2010

Note: Program Aide Training fills quickly. Register early to ensure placement.

Program Aide Core Training consists of two (8) hour sessions covering a variety of topics including the role of the Program Aide, child development, working with adults, leadership, communication skills, teambuilding, and Girl Scout program, as well as a Zink the Zebra diversity workshop and resources for songs and outdoor skills. In addition, Program Aide Core Training will include an emphasis on the Girl Scout Leadership Experience as girls will gain leadership skills for working with younger children.

Participants will earn the Program Aide pin by attending Session 1 and Session 2. After completing Program Aide Core Training, girls may choose to complete 25 hours of service as a Program Aide to earn the Program Aide patch through Day Camp staff opportunities or through another Girl Scout or other leadership experience where they plan and implement activities for younger children.

Girls must register for Session 1 and Session 2; choose from available dates/locations. Please list desired date(s) on your completed Registration Form.
