Kids: 50 to 74 hours
Young Adults: 100 to 174 hours
Adults: 100 to 249 hours
Groups: 200 to 499 hours



Silver Level

Kids: 75 to 99 hours
Young Adults: 175 to 249 hours
Adults: 250 to 499 hours
Groups: 500 to 999 hours



Gold Level

Kids: 100 hours or more
Young Adults: 250 hours or more
Adults: 500 hours or more
Groups: 1000 hours or more

4,000 hours or more of volunteer service (over a lifetime)

Presidential Volunteer Service Award

The Yorba Linda Girl Scout Association is pleased to announce our participation in the President's Service Award program as a Certifying Organization.

The President's Service Award recognizes individuals, families, and groups that have achieved a certain standard measured by the number of hours served over a 12-month period or cumulative hours earned over the course of a lifetime. To date, the President's Council has bestowed more than 400,000 awards to the Nation's deserving volunteers.

To qualify, volunteers simply submit a record of their service hours to the Yorba Linda Girl Scout Association, and we will verify the service and distribute the Award. Service hours can be accumulated through work on a variety of projects throughout the year. The only requirement is that the hours be completed within 12 months; recipients can qualify for a new Award each year.



Award Recipients receive:

- An official President's Volunteer Service Award pin
- A personalized certificate of achievement
- A note of congratulations from the President of the United States
- A letter from the President's Council on Service and Civic Participation

How to Sign-up
