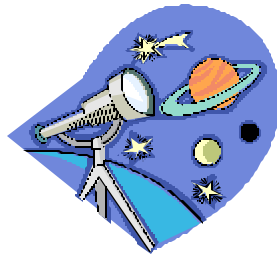


Tessmann Planetarium
