**PURPOSE OF POSITION:** To guide girls in planning and carrying out activities that will reflect their interests and develop their leadership skills within the framework and policies of GSUSA and GSOC.

**TERM:** Appointed by the Service Unit Manager / Coordinator for one year term.

**ACCOUNTABLE TO:** The Service Unit Manager / Coordinator.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Guide girls in planning activities that help them discover themselves, connect with others and take action so they experience fun and friendship while making the world a better place.
2. Meet with troop helpers to implement long range plans made by the girls.
3. Communicate troop plans and needs to parents.
4. Work to maintain at least 10 girl members in the troop.
5. Maintain records of the troops and submit Troop Financial Report by the stated deadline.
6. Coordinate troop representation at Service Unit, Association and GSOC meetings and events.
7. Keep Service Unit Organizer informed on current troop membership and number of available openings.
8. Forward all paperwork to Service Unit as required (Registration, Product Sales, Financial Report, etc.)
9. Utilize On-Line Features: i.e. e-Biz Registration, Volunteer Network, Training, Product Sales
10. Appoint Responsible Adults for troop and conduct safety briefings.
11. Complete Leadership Essentials Course within three months of initial appointment
12. Complete the volunteer application and background screening process, including registration and Orientation
13. Support and promote GSOC Product Sales and Fund Development activities.
14. Demonstrate a commitment to the mission, policies, standards and goals of GSUSA and GSOC.

**QUALITIES REQUIRED:**

1. **Focus on Girls:** help girls set realistic and clearly defined goals, experience Girl Scout Leadership and achieve outcomes via Discover, Connect and Take Action activities.
2. **Be Adaptable:** adjust and modify own behavior, and remain flexible and tolerant in changing situations.
3. **Foster Diversity:** understand and embrace differences.
4. **Communicate Clearly:** express ideas clearly and concisely.
5. **Demonstrate Personal Integrity:** model honesty, credibility and dependability for girls.

**VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT**
